Public transportation

From the train station SBB, take bus number 30 to the stop „Spalentor“ (3rd stop). Walk approx. 300 meters to the address Missionsstrasse 21.

Tram nr. 1: Take tram number 1 in the direction of „Dreirosenbrücke“ until the stop „Birmannsgasse“ (5th stop). Then walk down the street „Birmannsgasse“ until you reach the street „Missionsstrasse“. Missionsstrasse 21 is to your left.

From the train station „Badischer Bahnhof“ or from the exhibition area „Messe Basel“ take bus number 30 until the stop „Spalentor“. Walk approx. 300 meters to the address Missionsstrasse 21.

From the international airport „EuroAirport Basel/Mulhouse“, take bus number 50 to the train station (Bahnhof SBB). From there take bus number 30 to the stop „Spalentor“ (3rd stop). Walk approx. 300 meters to the address Missionsstrasse 21.
